HEALTH ALERT! OVERDOSE DEATHS!!

FENTANYL is being sold in:

- Pill form as fake **oxy**, **Xanax**, **Norco** and other club drugs
- Powder form as heroin, china white or fent

FENTANYL is 100x stronger than heroin.

Please tell friends who take pills there are fentanyl-contaminated fake pills being sold on the streets.

Multiple overdoses and <u>deaths</u> have been reported in Santa Cruz, Santa Clara, San Francisco, Sacramento and other areas.

There is <u>no</u> quality control or regulated manufacturing process. These fake drugs may contain toxic chemicals or have various levels of fentanyl in each batch. Even pills produced in the same batch may have very different levels of fentanyl, some of them <u>lethal</u>.

Prevent overdose by:

- Avoiding street/fake pills (most fentanyl poisonings are from fake pills)
- Never use alone (friends can save your life!)
- Keep naloxone with you (get from Janus).

M367 (325/10 APAP/hydrocodone)



Xanax bars (Pfizer 2.5mg alprazolam)



Norco 539 (Norco 325/10 hyrocodone/APAP)



A2155 (Actavis 30 mg oxycodone)



CDN80s (Canadian generic 80mg oxycodone)



IN CASE OF OVERDOSE

- 1. CALL 911 and give naloxone (Narcan)
- 2. Give RESCUE BREATHS every 5 seconds and/or follow the 911 dispatcher's instructions
- **3.** After naloxone stay with person for at least three hours or until help arrives

Signs of an Opioid Overdose:

- Face is pale and/or clammy to touch
- Body is limp
- Fingernails or lips have blue, gray or purple color
- Person is vomiting or making gurgling noises
- Person won't wake up from sleep or is unable to speak
- Breathing slows or even stops
- Heartbeat is very slow or stopped

Signs of an **Opioid Overmedication** (can progress to overdose):

- Unusual sleepiness or drowsiness, hard to wake from sleep
- Person is confused, has slurred speech or intoxicated behavior
- Slow or shallow breathing
- Pinpoint pupils
- Slow heartbeat, low blood pressure
