
Hospital Readmission Rates-Youth & Adult

Introduction

Federal Managed Care require County MHP's to monitor readmission rates of psychiatric hospitalizations.

- The County monitors re-hospitalization of Medi-Cal beneficiaries and unbenefited persons.
- The County tracks re-hospitalizations within 30 days of discharge from initial hospitalizations.
- The County Tracks the total number of re-hospitalizations per beneficiary per quarter.

Results for FY17-18 & FY16-17



<u>Description</u>: The MHP tracks the number of days between the initial discharge from a psychiatric hospitalization and rehospitalization of the same client. Goal is readmission rate no higher than 20%.

Frequency: Reported quarterly, available approximately 4 weeks after the end of each quarter.

<u>Calculation:</u> Number (N) of Medi-Cal beneficiaries (and unbenefited) who are re-hospitalized within 30 days.

FY 17-18 N = 92 FY16-17 N = 57 Adults FY 17-18 N = 14 FY16-17 N = 9 Children

Denominator: Number of Medi-Cal beneficiaries (and unbenefited) hospitalized.

FY17-18 N = 525 Readmission Rate = 18% Adults FY16-17 N = 446 Readmission Rate = 13% Adults FY17-18 N = 88 Readmission Rate = 16% Children FY16-17 N = 59 Readmission Rate = 15% Children
